ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR FULL TIME COURT COMMISSIONER

Superior Court Commissioner Leon Henley Jr. has announced his retirement for late 2024. Whatcom County Superior Court is accepting applications from qualified individuals interested in serving as Court Commissioner effective January 2025. This position serves at the pleasure of the Superior Court Bench. Salary is \$205,440 (90% of Superior Court Judge).

Whatcom County offers excellent benefits, including medical, dental, and vision coverage for employees and their family, and life insurance coverage for employees. We offer attractive paid leave provisions, including vacation, sick leave, and 12 holidays per year (on average). Employees participate in Washington State's Retirement System through joint contributions with the County. Additionally, we provide an employee assistance program and tax-preferred options for employees to invest their money in deferred compensation and/or flexible spending plan for health care/dependent care. Per Unrepresented Resolution, Commissioners are compensated at 90% of Superior Court Judges salary.
