Dear Voter,

Voters in the upcoming Primary Election will decide, for several contests, the top two candidates that will appear on the November General Election ballot. These are important races. Your vote will help determine who moves forward to the General Election for Legislative Districts 40 and 42, Secretary of State, US Senator, Congressional District 2, Whatcom County Prosecutor and District Court Judge Position 2. Be aware that some contests have only one candidate because they are partisan races and are required to appear on the primary election ballot.

Help us make sure your vote is counted. The top two reasons ballots may not be counted are signature problems and late ballots. In the 2021 Primary, 398 ballots were turned in late and 251 had signature issues. These problems are easy to avoid. Here's how:

Signatures:

- Be sure to sign your return envelope before returning it.
- Sign your return envelope yourself. Do not let anybody else sign your envelope for you – we do compare every signature to the signatures on file in your voter registration record.
- Sign the return envelope with your name printed on it.
- If you are unable to sign your regular signature, get two witness signatures.
- If we send you a letter to fix your signature issue, sign it and return it in the postage paid envelope.

That's it! Follow these simple steps and your ballot won't be challenged for signature reasons.

Late Ballots:

- To avoid a late ballot, use a drop box by 8:00 p.m. election night.
- If you use the mail, mail it early to be sure of an on-time postmark. Your ballot must be postmarked no later than election day.
- If you must mail your ballot on election day, check the cut-off time posted on every mailbox. If you mail your ballot after that cut-off time your ballot will be postmarked the following day and will be too late to be counted.

Easy, right? We want to count every ballot that gets returned. Follow these steps to help us do that.

Most importantly, use this voters' guide to learn more about the election, including the candidate statements. Then mark your ballot, and return it. Every vote matters.

Voter's Declaration

I do solemnly swear or affirm under penalty of perjury that I am: a citizen of the United States; a resident of the state of Washington and meet the requirements for voting mandated by state law; at least 18 years old on election day; voting only once in this election; not under the authority of the Department of Corrections for a Washington felony conviction; not disqualified from voting due to a court order; and not voting in any other jurisdiction in the United States for this election.

It is illegal to forge a signature or cast another person's ballot. Attempting to vote when not qualified, attempting to vote more than once, or falsely signing this declaration is a felony punishable by a maximum imprisonment of five years, a maximum fine of \$10,000, or both.

Have your mark witnessed and signed by two people.

- We compare the signature on your ballot envelope with the signature on your voter registration. This is how we know you voted the ballot. Every signature is reviewed and verified!

How do we get your signature?

If you register or update using a paper registration form, we capture your signature from the form.

If you register or update through the Department of Motor Vehicles, we capture the signature from your Washington State Driver License or I.D. card.

- Do not sign for another registered voter.
- A Power of Attorney does not have authority to sign for the voter. If a voter is unable to sign, they should make a mark on the signature line and have their mark witnessed by two people. The two witnesses need to sign on the lines provided.
- Our office can have more than one signature on file for you. If you want to provide another signature, please contact us with that request (*Signature Update Request*).

To Register to Vote, You Must Be:

- A citizen of the United States.
- A Washington State resident that meets the requirements for voting mandated by state law.
- At least 18 years old on election day, or 17 years old at the primary and 18 years old by the day of the November general election.
- Not disqualified from voting due to a court order.
- Not serving a sentence of total confinement under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections for a Washington felony conviction or currently incarcerated for a federal or out-of-state felony conviction.

How to Register to Vote:



ONLINE: Go to VoteWA.gov on or before **Monday, July 25** if you have a current Washington State Driver License or I.D. card.



PAPER FORM: Complete and return a Washington State Voter Registration Form. **Forms must be received in the Auditor's Office by July 25.** Registration forms are available at city halls, libraries, online, or by contacting the Whatcom County Auditor's Office.



IN PERSON: Come into the Whatcom County Auditor's Office, Election Division, by 8:00 pm on Election Day.

Registration Deadlines:



Voter registration and address changes online or by mail **must be received by July 25.**

Starting July 26, visit our office in person to register to vote or update your current registration by 8:00 pm Election Day.

Washington Votes by Mail Every Election!

- If you are registered to vote in Washington, there is no need to request a ballot. Active voters will be mailed a ballot before each election. Log in and view your registration at VoteWA.gov.
- Voting by mail is accessible, convenient, and gives you time to learn about the candidates and ballot measures.
- ALL signatures are verified before the ballot is counted.
- Results are neither known nor reported before 8:00 pm on Election Day.

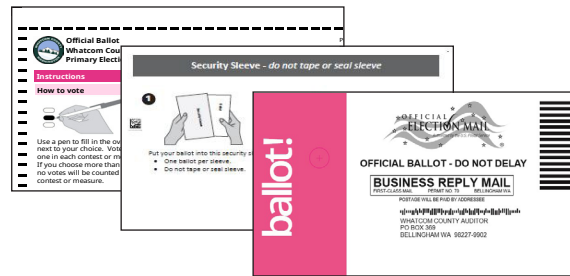


Accessible Voting Unit (AVU)

An accessible voting unit (AVU) is equipped with visual and audio technology. Voters requiring reasonable accommodation or assistance may vote on the AVU in the Auditor's Office starting July 13 through August 2.



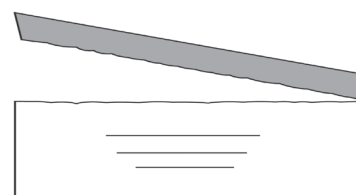
1. The ballot packet for the August 2 Primary Election will be mailed to you on July 13. The packet will include your official ballot, a security sleeve, and a postage-paid return envelope.



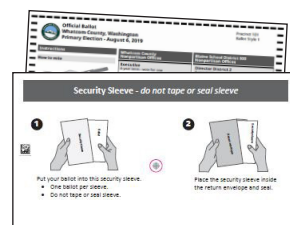
2. To vote the ballot, fill in the oval next to your choice with a blue or black pen. Vote for only one in each contest.



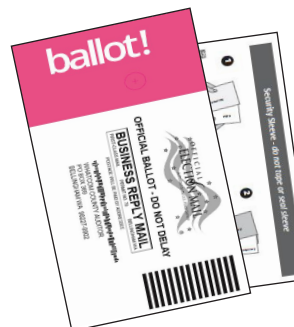
3. Remove the stub at the top of your ballot. *If you forget to remove the stub, your ballot will still be counted.*



4. Place your voted ballot into the security sleeve. *If you forget the security sleeve, your ballot will still be counted.*



5. Put the ballot/security sleeve into the return envelope and seal.

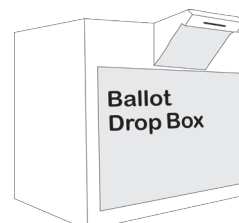


6. Sign and date your return envelope that has your name printed on it. **Your signature on the return envelope is required for your ballot to be counted.**

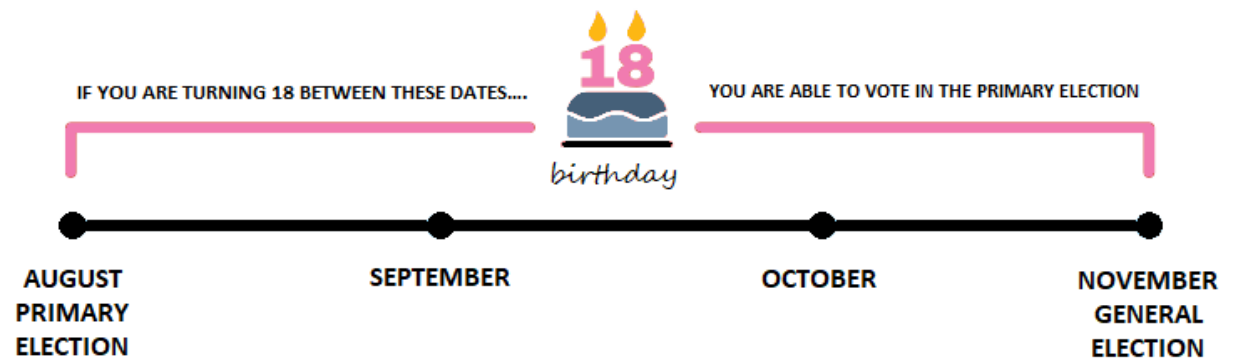

Primary Only Voters

A 17-year-old who is registered to vote and will be 18 by the November 8 General Election will be eligible to vote in the August 2 Primary Election.



Primary only voters can participate in:

- nonpartisan candidate races that contain three or more candidates appearing on a primary ballot
- partisan candidate races, regardless of the number of candidates, appearing on a primary ballot
- presidential primary (every 4 years)

Primary only voters are not eligible to participate in:

- ballot measures
- contests where a candidate is deemed elected at the primary
- precinct committee officer
- freeholder
- charter review
- commissioners elected to a newly formed jurisdiction

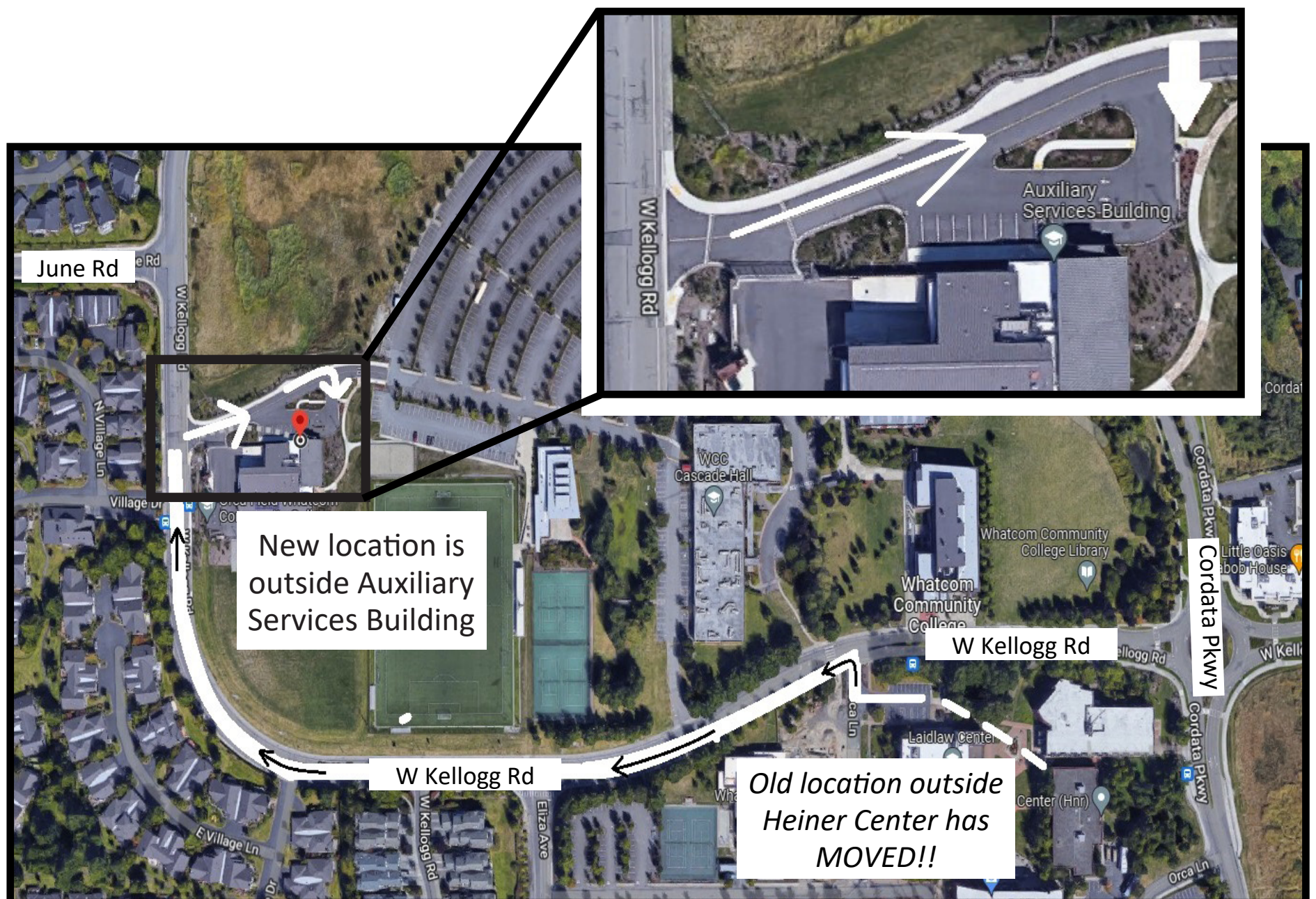

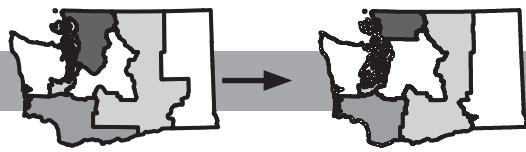

Your District May Have Changed



Every 10 years, following the U.S. Census, district boundaries are redrawn in a process called redistricting. Districts involved include legislative, congressional, and county council.

Redistricting ensures that each district has about the same number of people, which means equal representation in government.

As a result of redistricting, you may have been assigned to a new legislative, congressional, or county council district.

If your districts changed, you will vote on different legislative or congressional races, beginning this year.

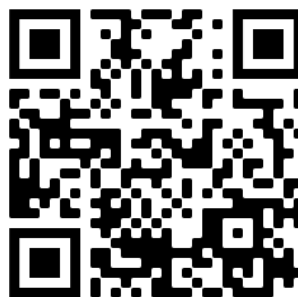

Precinct Changes

Whatcom County has adopted new precinct boundaries. The county council reviewed the proposal at the April 12, 2022 council meeting and voted in favor of adopting the new precinct boundaries. 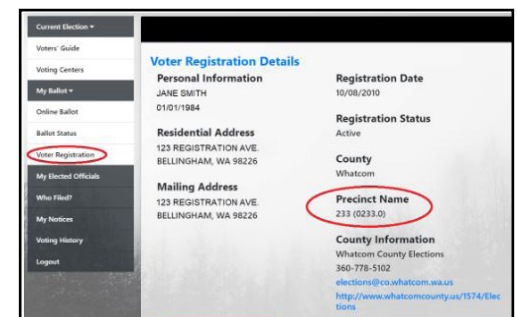

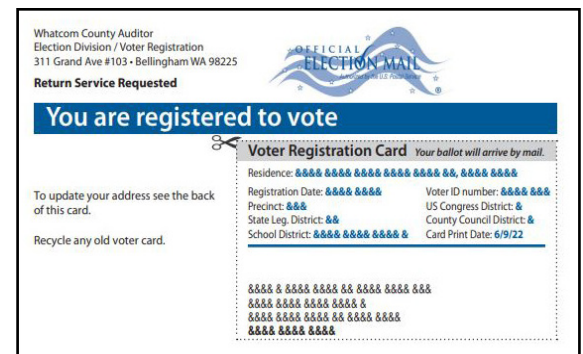
You can register to vote or update your address in Washington State with your Washington State ID or driver license at VoteWA.gov.

Once registered, you can view personalized voter information, including:

- A list of past elections in which you returned a ballot

Write-In Voting

Write-in candidates must file a Declaration of Candidacy to have votes tallied. Write-in candidates have until 8:00 pm on Election Day to file their Declaration.

To cast a vote for a declared write-in candidate, fill in the oval next to the write-in line on the ballot and write the name of the qualified candidate on the line provided.

Write-in votes are not permitted for the office of Precinct Committee Officer.

What is a Sample Ballot?

Candidate statements in this pamphlet will be printed in the order they appear on this Sample Ballot.

Political Party Precinct Committee Officer - Partisan Office

For this office only: In order to vote for precinct committee officer, a partisan office, you must affirm that you are a Democrat or a Republican and may vote only for one candidate from the party you select.

Your vote for a candidate affirms your affiliation with the same party as the candidate. This preference is private and will not be matched to your name or shared.

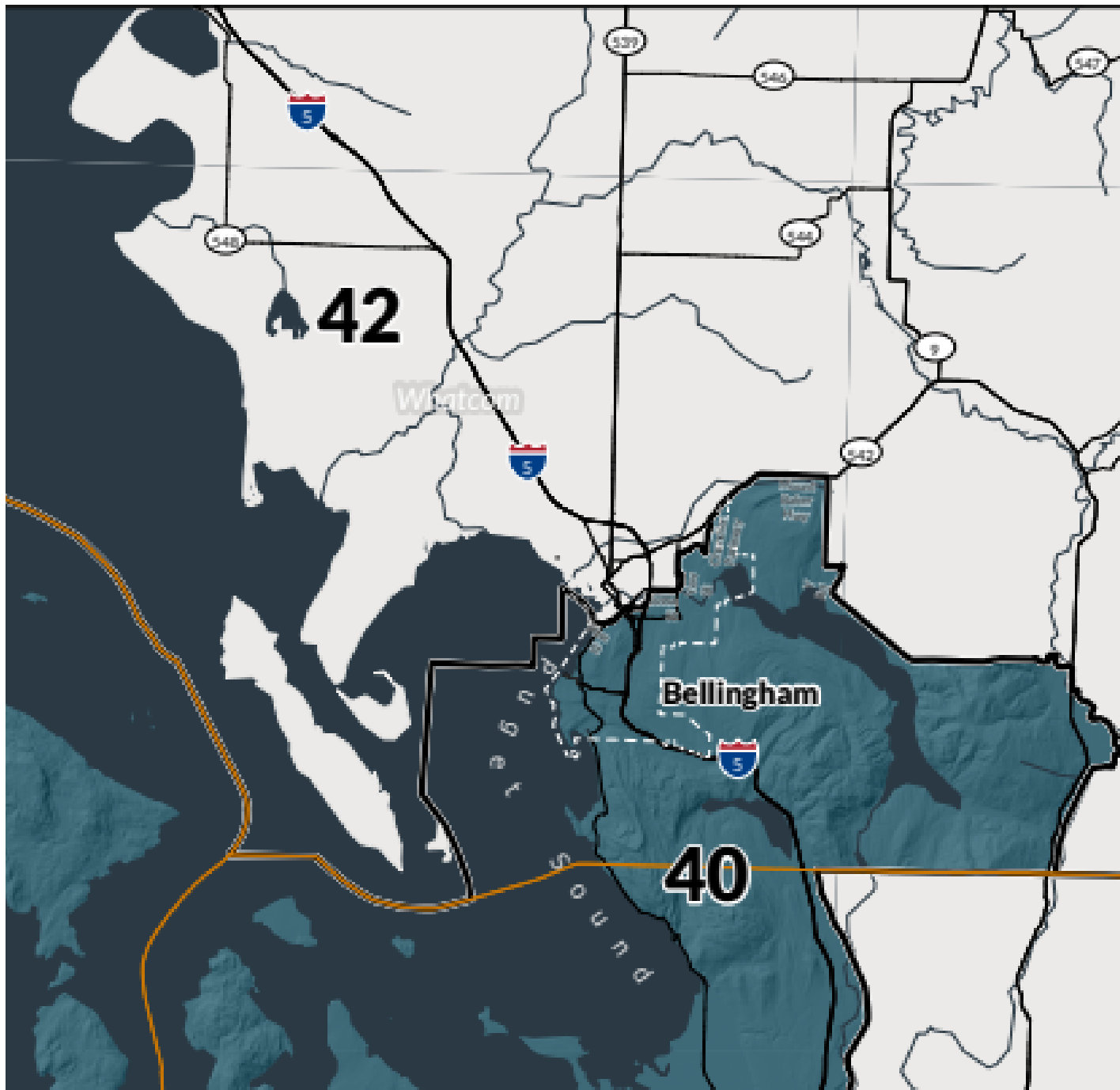

- Someone other than the voter has signed the return envelope.
- Signature on the return envelope doesn't match the signature we have on file.
- Ballot received with a late postmark, or late to an official ballot drop box.
- Return envelope is not signed.

Helpful Information

Do not let someone else sign for you

Sign and date the voter declaration on the return envelope that has your name printed on it. We compare the signature on your ballot envelope with the signature on your voter registration. This is how we know you voted the ballot. Every signature is reviewed and verified!

Update your signature on file

Keeping your signature up-to-date is important. Your signature on file is not only used to accept your ballot but it is also used to verify your signature on petitions. Our office can have more than one signature on file for you. If you want to provide another signature, please contact us with that request.

Sign and return the signature correction letter

If you received a signature correction letter, make sure you sign the letter the same way you signed your ballot. The signature correction letter can be mailed, emailed, or faxed and must be received by the Auditor's Office before 4:30 pm on August 15.

Voter's Declaration

I do solemnly swear or affirm under penalty of perjury that I am a citizen of the United States, a resident of the state of Washington and meet the requirements for voting mandated by state law; at least 18 years old on election day; voting only once in this election; not under the authority of the Department of Corrections for a Washington felony conviction; not disqualified from voting due to a court order; and not voting in any other jurisdiction in the United States for this election.

It is illegal to forge a signature or cast another person's ballot. Attempting to vote when not qualified, attempting to vote more than once, or falsely signing this declaration is a felony punishable by a maximum imprisonment of five years, a maximum fine of \$10,000, or both.

**My (spouse, roommate) signed my ballot envelope. What should I do?**

If someone has mistakenly signed your return envelope, draw a line through the incorrect signature and sign your name directly above the correction.

I forgot to put my ballot in the included security sleeve!

Your ballot will count as long as you have signed the return envelope, the security sleeve is not required.

I reopened my ballot envelope and sealed it shut with tape. Will my vote still count?

Yes! As long as the signature on your return envelope matches your registration signature, your vote will count.

I received two ballots, does that mean I get to vote twice?

Sorry you don't get to vote twice! If you have recently moved or changed your address multiple ballots may be mailed to you. Each ballot envelope has a unique barcode which prevents voting multiple times. Once a ballot has been received all other ballots are suspended.

I got a letter saying my signature did not match the signature on file with your election office. Is my ballot not going to count?

All signatures are verified by staff trained by the Washington State Patrol. Staff are trained to look for signature similarities and patterns. However, signatures often change and your signature may no longer match what is currently on file. If you received a signature challenge letter, please sign the letter and promptly return it to our office via mail or email as soon as possible. Your ballot will be counted as soon as we receive your signed letter. Your updated signature letter will also be scanned and your new signature will be added to our database.

I lost/misplaced/damaged my original ballot. How do I get another one?

You have options to receive a replacement ballot, you may:

- Print one online at VoteWA.gov (log in and select Online Ballot)
- Call or email our office to request (as time allows)
- Visit us in person

**Ballot Processing is Livestreamed**

Watch what is happening in the Election Center from home! Scan the QR code to go directly to our website (www.whatcomcounty.us/Elections).

1. Assembling & Mailing the Ballot Packet: Your ballot packet is assembled and mailed by July 13, 2022. Ballot packets include a ballot, security sleeve, return envelope and informational insert. Additional lists are sent weekly for any recently added or updated registrants. *Ballot packets for Military & Overseas voters were mailed on June 17.*

2. Voting your Ballot: Your ballot packet should arrive by July 21. You have until election day to vote and return your ballot. Return your ballot in: ballot drop box by 8:00 pm August 2, or in the mail postmarked by August 2.



3. Collecting & Sorting Returned Ballots: Ballots are collected from ballot drop boxes and the post office daily. The mail sorting machine takes a picture of the signature on the return envelope, to be used during signature verification. It also scans the barcode on the return envelope, which will mark the ballot as being Received.

4. Checking the signature on the Return Envelope: All signatures are checked before the ballot can be counted. We compare the signature on the Return Envelope with the signature(s) we have on file for each voter. Ballots with a matching signature are Accepted, ballot envelopes with a signature issue are Challenged/Rejected. If the signature does not match, or is unsigned, the voter will be mailed a letter to correct the issue, and will also be contacted by phone after Election Day.



5. Opening the Ballots: Ballots are put into groups for processing. First the security sleeve containing the ballot is removed from the return envelope (ballots returned without a security sleeve are counted). Secondly, ballots are removed from the security sleeve and inspected. Workers are inspecting the ballot to ensure the votes marked will be read by the scanning equipment. Ballots needing additional adjudication/review are flagged.



6. Scanning the Ballot: The ballots are scanned. Images are stored on a secure and closed system (no internet access). Once scanned, the ballots are kept in a sealed, tamper evident bag.



7. Reviewing the Ballot: After scanning, the electronic images are viewed. Reviewers are adjudicating ballots by reviewing overvotes (more than one choice marked), undervotes (no choices marked), and write-ins. Workers use the Washington State Voter Intent Manual to ensure decisions are made consistently. Any unresolved ballots are reviewed by the Canvassing Board.

8. Reporting Results: Results of the election are unknown until after 8:00 pm August 2. Tabulation occurs at 8:00 pm election night, and posted to our website soon after. Results are uploaded after election day as long as there are ballots to be counted. The primary election will be certified on August 16, 2022.

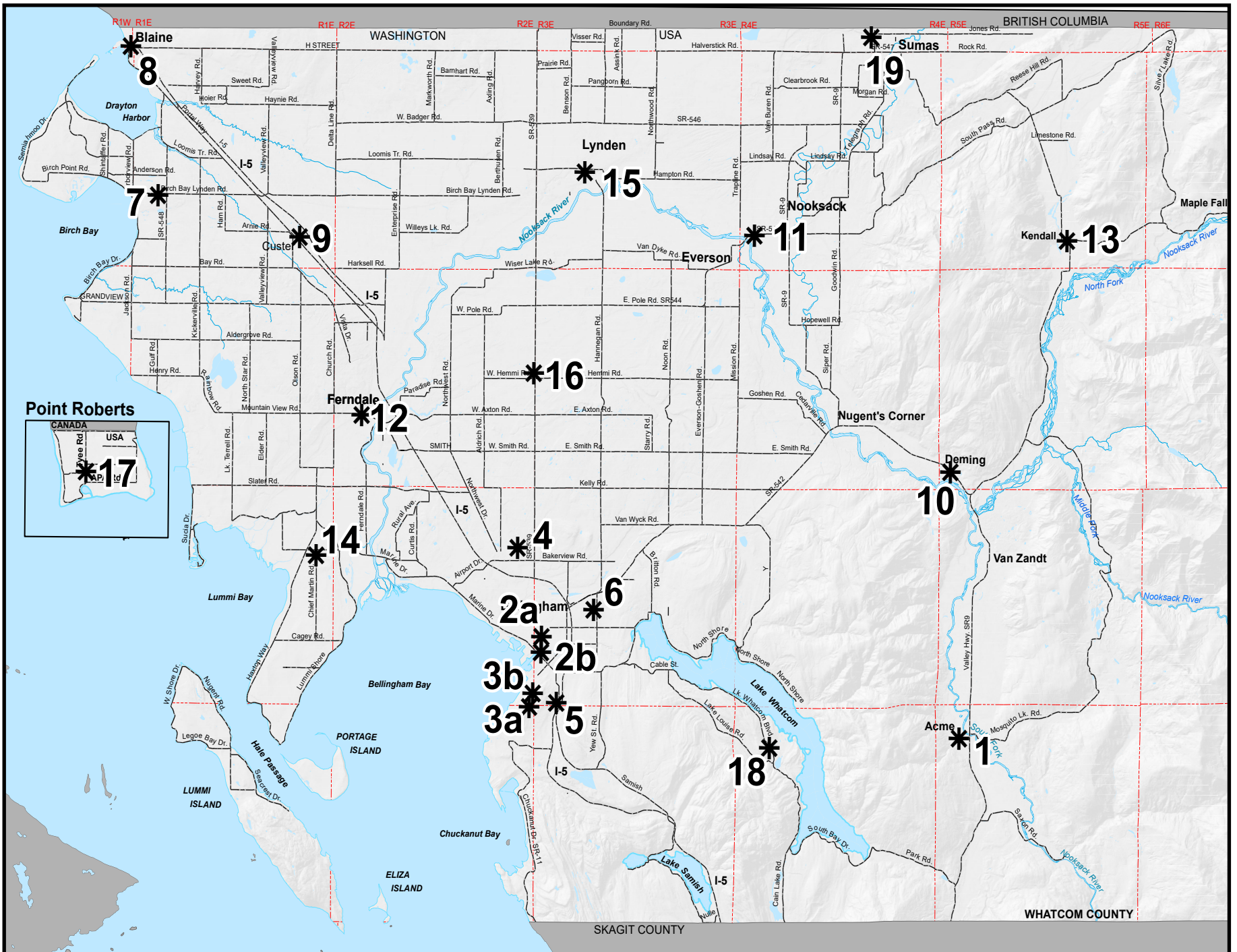
