SAMPLE BALLOT WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON PRIMARY ELECTION - AUGUST 19, 2008

To Vote: Use either blue or black ink. Do not use a felt tip pen or pencil.

Connect The Head and Tail of the arrow that points to your choice with a **Single Line** as shown.



- **IF YOU MAKE A MISTAKE:** Draw a line through the entire candidate's name like this: ~~John Doe~~ You then have the option of making another choice if you wish.
- **Write-In:** To vote for a person not on the ballot, connect the arrow and write in the name of the person on the line provided.
- **Overvote:** More than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an overvote and no votes for that office or measure will be counted.
- **More Instructions:** See enclosed instruction insert.
