\*Total number of voters credited includes voters (-2) whose ballots the Canvassing Board rejected but could not be traced back to individual voters to take credit away. It also does not contain the voters who vote pursuant to the Address Confidentiality Program (+3) which are not entered into the election management system.

This number differs from the actual ballots counted by 2. (55,057 vs 55059 actual count) It is our conclusion that there was probably human error in entering envelopes into the system, on the reconciliation log sheets, or in the report generating process that resulted in the election management system not registering two of the ballots that were actually counted.
