Mr. Buckingham made a motion to reject the 2 challenged ballots and count the accepted ballots; the motion passed unanimously.







Mr. Donovan made a motion to certify the election; the motion passed unanimously.


Diana, Royce, and Todd signed the certification of the February 8, 2022 Macaulay Creek Flood Control District Election.
