Voting Tips

Sign your envelope.

The signature on your return envelope is compared to the signature(s) on your voter registration record. Trained election workers verify each and every signature.

Return on time.

- By Official Ballot Drop Box before 8:00 pm sharp on November 5
- By Mail postmarked by November 5

Track your ballot.

Visit VoteWA.gov to see if your ballot has been received and accepted by the Auditor's Office.

Text the word "Vote" to 868392 to receive text message notifications when your ballot has been received and accepted.

General Election November 5, 2024

If a primary election was held for an office, the two candidates who received the most votes in the Primary advanced to the General Election.

Each candidate for partisan office may state a political party that he or she prefers. A candidate's preference does not imply that the candidate is nominated or endorsed by the party, or that the party approves of or associates with that candidate.

Voting Instructions:

Vote:

- Mark your ballot.
- Put your ballot in the security sleeve.
- Place the security sleeve inside the return envelope and seal.

Sign:

- Sign & date the voter declaration on your ballot return envelope. The signature on the envelope must match the signature(s) in your voter registration record.

Return:

- Return your ballot to the Auditor's Office, Election Division. More information is on the back of this page.
